

FREE WATER HOOK-UP/FREE WELL CAPPING OPPORTUNITY

The City of Kalamazoo has started reaching out to people on Riverview Drive and other streets (related to the PFAS contamination) who are not currently connected to city water.

You currently have the opportunity to be hooked up to city water and have your well capped for no charge. If you do not hook-up to the water now, we want to clarify what your costs and options will be in the future:

- Hook-ups to city water and capping your well later will cost approximately \$5,500. The estimated charges are subject to increases in the future.
- If your well fails; you will be mandated by the Kalamazoo County Health Department to hook-up to City Water and have your well capped. No well permits will be issued in these areas in the future.
- Filters and bottled water will no longer be provided by the Health Department.
- You will be billed quarterly by the City of Kalamazoo Water Department. Current quarterly charge is approximately \$83.83 for a single household based on estimated use of 200/gallons per day. Billing is based on actual usage.
