## TUESDAY

All homes on the north side of D Ave. to Baseline. Both sides of D Ave. from Westnedge to Sprinkle. Riverview, north of E. Ave. Also all homes off of Springbrook and E. Ave. east of Riverview.

## WEDNESDAY

All homes on E. Ave and Springbrook west of Riverview. All homes on Riverview south of E. Ave. on both sides. All remaining homes between 24th and the Kalamazoo River north of G Ave.

## THURSDAY

All homes on the south side of D. Ave. from 12th St. to Westnedge. All remaining homes between 12th St. to both sides of Westnedge.

### Paper

Paper (staples okay)  
Newspaper  
Envelopes  
Junk mail  
Phone books  
Magazines



### Cardboard

Ream wrappers  
File folders  
Poster board  
Frozen food boxes  
Cardboard boxes  
Milk cartons



### Plastic

Water bottles  
Take-out containers  
Soda bottles



### Metal

Aluminum beverage cans  
Food cans



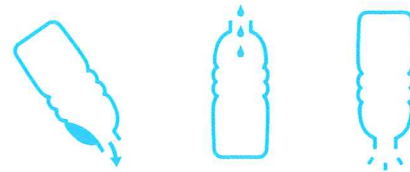
### Glass

Bottles (clear, green & brown)  
Jars

## Holiday Recycling Guide

Boxes (gift, shoe and shipping)  
Wrapping paper (plain or sparkly)  
Cards and envelopes (without embellishments)  
Gift bags (paper)



**Empty. Clean. Dry.**

Please make sure your recyclables are **empty, clean and dry** before placing them in your recycling cart.



## Non-recyclable

These items can **never** be placed in your recycling cart:

Paper, milk or juice cartons  
Polystyrene foam  
Containers/packing  
Propane tanks  
Paint or oil cans  
Medical waste

Liquids of any kind  
Plastic bags  
Bubble wrap  
Ribbons and bows  
Gift bags (laminated, coated or dyed)  
Cellophane

Packing peanuts (polystyrene foam)  
Chemicals (dry or liquids)  
Household cleaners  
Trash of any kind  
Pizza boxes  
Bagged film plastics
