Enclosed is your 2017 summer tax bill. Please be sure and review the tax bill due dates. <u>Interest and penalties are</u> assessed after the due date.

If you mail your check or pay through your bank with an online payment, please consider confirming, before the due date, that your payment was received by our office. We have had cases of online payments taking up to two weeks before we receive the payment or payments never arriving at all. You can call our office for confirmation of payment or visit our website to access tax information online.

At this time Cooper Township doesn't accept credit or debit card payments. Online payments can be made through Official Payments at www.officialpayments.com. Our jurisdiction code is 7131. Please be aware.....Official Payments charges a 3% convenience fee for this service.

2017 Road Projects

As part of our ongoing road maintenance, the Townshp Board has allocated funds towards the following road projects for 2017. The Road Commission of Kalamazoo County has already begun working on these projects. - 7. Fineview Avenue—Douglas Avenue to North Westnedge Avenue
- 8. 20th Street—G Avenue to McKinley Avenue
- 9. Solvel Street—G Avenue to Thayer Avenue
- 10. Tibet Drive—1382' West of Canton Drive to Canton Drive
- 11. Stoney Hill Drive—Rolling Meadows Drive to 625' East of Rolling Meadows Dr
- 12. E Avenue, 23rd Street and DE Avenue—Riverview Drive to North Sprinkle Rd
- 13. Baseline Road—Riverview Drive to 22nd Street and Douglas Avenue to 16th St

SUMMER REMINDERS!!

- Your grass must be 8 inches or less in height or the township will mow and bill you on your winter tax bill.
- Be cautious using fireworks and w make sure they're discharged in a safe area and in compliance with state law.
- Warmer weather brings open
- Warmer weather brings open windows; try and monitor your noise level, especially between 10pm and 8am.

 Garage sale advertising signs are only allowed during the time that the sale is actually going on. Signs left up after the end of the garage sale are in violation of the Ordinance and the property owner where the garage sale was taking place will be cited.

 No open burning other than that which is in compliance with the burning ordinance.

 Bonfires must be less than 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet high. They must be contained in a fire ring or other device designed for recreational burning. Someone must remain with the fire until it is completely extinguished. A water source such as a bucket or hose must be available.

 Keep grills at least ten feet from structures or combustible materials!!
