Kalamazoo County Municipalities,

Michigan's Solid Waste Program has been updated with the passage of significant amendments to Part 115, Solid Waste Management of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, Act 451 of 1994 (MCL 324.11571(1)) which became effective on March 29, 2023 (the "Act.") The amendments require that the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy ("EGLE") ensure each county in the State of Michigan has an approved materials management plan ("MMP").

Per the requirements of the Act, Kalamazoo County submitted a Notice of Intent to prepare a single-county MMP to EGLE on June 26, 2024. Per Section 11571 (9)(a) of the Act, Kalamazoo County is sending the attached copy of notification to the legislative body of each municipality within Kalamazoo County.

Per Section 11571 (9)(c), Kalamazoo County requests that you publish this notice of intent on your website. Kalamazoo County has published this notice on the main page of the County website under "County News": <https://www.kalcounty.com/>
